### DESCRIPTION

For the past five years, Burmese people have been largely unable to celebrate the traditional New Year due to the COVID-19 pandemic and the military coup in Myanmar. This April, the College of San Mateo Burmese Students Association (CSM BurSA) hopes to share this cultural festival with the wider CSM student body.

The main indoor activities will take place inside Building 10, in front of the Learning Center. A live band will perform traditional Burmese music, and prepackaged traditional food and drinks will be available. The space will also feature art showcases and educational posters introducing the Thingyan festival and providing context about the current situation in Myanmar (Burma).

There will be interactive games and activities such as ring toss and custom sticker making outside. A designated area will also be set up where participants can lightly bless each other with water, a traditional part of Thingyan celebrations, and take photos.
