
5. Committee Updates

6. Panopto Course Copy v2 Share Out

- Sebrianne Ferguson shared about the new Panopto
 - No good way to copy videos from one course to another in Canvas. They get a lot of tickets about this in ITS. Sebrianne has done some trainings on how to change the sharing permissions, or a batch copy, but it isn't really straightforward. There is a new way that allows this to be easier called Course Copy v2.
 - It will be launched on 4/9 (when summer course shells come out) to give faculty the most control over how their content is copied. Course Video Copy section makes this easier.
